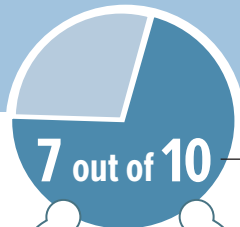

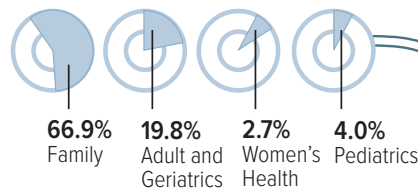
PRIMARY CARE FOCUS

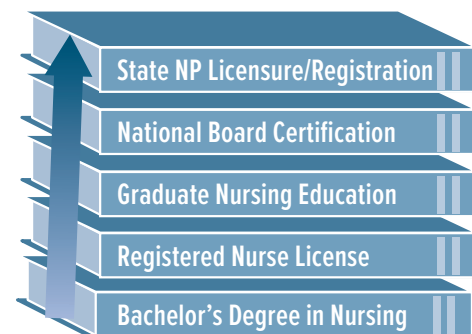
MORE THAN **87%** PREPARED IN PRIMARY CARE



AREA OF PRIMARY CARE PREPARATION



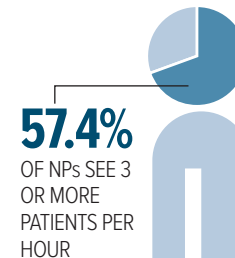

NPs AT A GLANCE

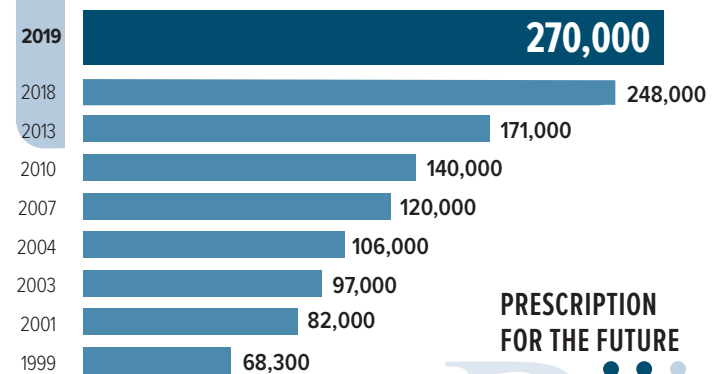
- More than **5 decades** of improving patient access and quality care
