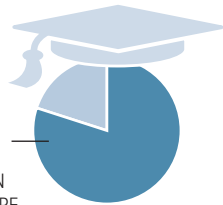

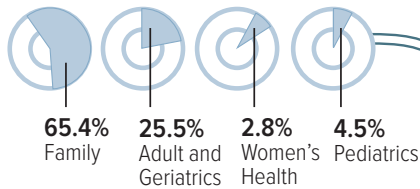
PRIMARY CARE FOCUS

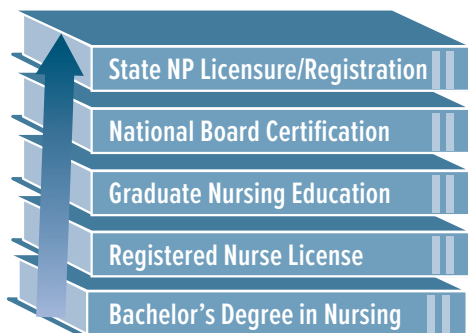
MORE THAN **89%** PREPARED IN PRIMARY CARE



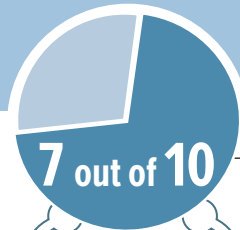
AREA OF PRIMARY CARE PREPARATION

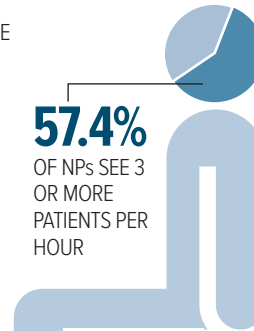
NPs AT A GLANCE

Prescribe medications in all **50 states** and D.C.

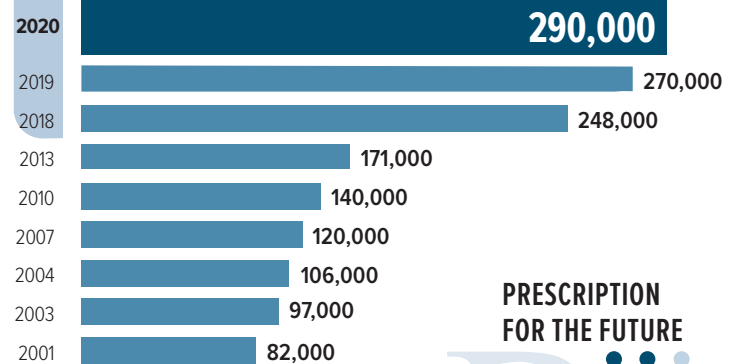
