Your application with a nonrefundable application fee of \$150 must be submitted on or before the submission deadline.

Authors may submit more than one industry scientific poster abstract (referred to as "industry poster abstract" or "abstract"). However, only one abstract will be accepted per primary author/presenter.

The number of industry poster abstracts included within the conference schedule may be limited.

INDUSTRY POSTER ABSTRACT RULES

- Abstracts must be no longer than one page (400 words or less), with font size 11 or 12 and all margins one inch.
- The content described must be appropriate for a poster presentation.
- Research abstracts must include title and author information.
- Purpose, methodology, results and implications for NPs must be clearly identified.
- This cover sheet must be completed and included with the abstract.
- The abstract must be accompanied by a one- or two-page bio-sketch (CVs not accepted).
- Advertising and/or commercial materials may not be distributed.
- Only generic names of drugs and other products may be used in the body of the exhibit/poster.

AANP strongly recommends that all presentations do not use references such as physicians, MD, nurse, mid-level clinician, etc., when referring to nurse practitioners. Please use generic clinician language such as health care providers or reference them as NPs or nurse practitioners. There should be no demeaning references to NPs/nurse practitioners within the poster.

It is recommended you not place any items of value on display in your poster area until your poster personnel are in attendance.

Because AANP accredits the general (non-industry sponsored) posters for CE credit, industry sponsored poster space will be separated (or set apart) from the other posters. Your application and space assignment are subject to acceptance by AANP. AANP reserves the right to restrict any scientific exhibit/poster that, in the opinion of AANP, is deemed promotional, commercial or unethical.

By submitting an application, the presenting author and/or the sponsoring company agree to the following:

INDEMNIFICATION - The presenting author and sponsoring company agrees to indemnify, protect, save and keep American Association of Nurse Practitioners (AANP), Meeting Management Associates (MMA), Freeman and the Indiana Convention Center and each of their parents, subsidiaries and affiliates and each of their officers, directors, members, guests, agents and employees (individually and collectively the "Indemnified Parties") forever harmless from any and all claims for personal injury or death, or losses or damages to property in connection with the presenting author and sponsoring company's participation in the 2019 AANP National Conference, and any and all losses, damages or charges imposed for violation of any law or

The presenting author and sponsoring company agree that if he/she is utilizing copyrighted material of others, he/she will provide AANP with a copy of the written permission provided to me by the owner of the copyright. This includes, but is not limited to, the use of photos, graphics and music owned by others. He/she also agrees that if such a copy of this written permission is not provided to AANP, he/she will remove all such material from referenced poster.

The presenting author and sponsoring company agree that AANP may remove any material deemed to be inappropriate in AANP's sole discretion.
