Applicants must be certified nurse practitioners (NPs) or graduate students expected to complete their project in 2020. Applicants may receive \$5,000 in grant funding. Only completed applications will be accepted and reviewed. The application deadline is March 20, 2019, at 5 p.m. CT.</p> <p>*If you are selected for a grant, you will be required to complete and sign a written Acknowledgement.</p>
<p>Eligibility Requirements</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must be a U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident • Must not be a member of the or relative of a current AANP Board Member or State Representative • Must not be staff or related to AANP staff • Have not been funded by AANP within the last three calendar years • Expected to complete project by December 31, 2020
