

Kahlil Demonbreun, DNP, RNC-OB, WHNP-BC, ANP-BC, FAANP, FAAN is recognized as a pioneering model of male nursing roles in women's health care. Dr. Demonbreun is currently the Women's Health Medical Director at the Columbia Veterans Affairs Health Care System in Columbia, SC. He received a Diploma in Nursing from the Henry Ford Hospital School of Nursing, Bachelor's of Science in Nursing and Master's of Science in Nursing degrees from the University of SC, and a Doctor of Nursing Practice degree from the Medical University of SC. He holds board certifications as a Women's Health Nurse Practitioner, Adult Nurse Practitioner, and Inpatient Obstetric Nurse.

He is a Fellow of the American Association of Nurse Practitioners (FAANP), Fellow of the American Academy of Nursing (FAAN), member of the National Association of Women's Health Nurse Practitioners (NPWH), member of the American Nurses Association (ANA), and the SC Nurses Association (SCNA).

Dr. Demonbreun is the present AANP State Representative for SC, member of the AANP National Health Policy Committee, member of the FAANP Selection Committee, serves on the Board of Directors of the National Certification Corporation, and is the immediate Past Chair for the SC Board of Nursing's Advanced Practice Committee.
