

# State Policy Fact Sheet: Northern Mariana Islands

## **Nurse Practice Act:**

3 CMC §§ 2301

### **Regulatory Structure: Full Practice**

Northern Mariana Islands practice and licensure laws authorize nurse practitioners (NPs) to evaluate patients, diagnose and prescribe medications and therapeutic measures.

#### Regulatory Agency

NP licensure is regulated exclusively by the Board of Nursing. 3 CMC §§ 2305

#### Licensure Requirements

Requirements include a registered nurse license, a graduate degree in an NP role and national certification. § 140-60.1-210

#### Continuing Education (CE)\*

Thirty contact hours are required every two-year renewal cycle. § 140-60.1-232

#### Medical Staff Membership\*\*

Law provides for a Director of Nursing, who is responsible for the daily operations of the nurses who are employed at a comprehensive health care center (CHCC), such as hospitals and clinics, including the nursing unit. 3 CMC § 2828

#### **Primary Care Providers**

NPs are defined as primary care providers.

§ 140-60.1-420 & § 140-60.1-020

#### Signature Recognition on Items of Patient Care

- Physical Therapy: NPs are permitted to refer to physical therapy.

- Parking Permits: NPs are not authorized to provide proof of disability for disabled parking permits.

- Death Certificates: NPs are not presently authorized to sign death certificates.
  1 CMC § 26013
