

Requests for Analytic Work

Background

The AANP research program is home to a wealth of information about nurse practitioners collected through periodic surveys and studies. Reports from these surveys and studies are made available on AANP’s website at www.aanp.org/research/reports. In order to meet the needs or preferences of individual members, researchers or organizations, custom reports can be obtained by requesting analytic work from AANP. Individuals with specific questions regarding characteristics of NP practice, employment or compensation are encouraged to apply.

How to Apply

1. Fill out the online request form at surveymonkey.com/r/analyticrequest
2. Sign the agreement form
3. Pay the non-refundable analytic fee
4. Receive your results

Upon submission of the online application, you will be contacted within three business days to confirm your request in a letter of agreement that will include the report description for verification and an estimation of the total cost and timeline. The analytic work can only begin once the agreement is signed and returned to AANP. All reports are copyrighted by AANP and no information contained within the reports may be reproduced in any form or for any purpose without written consent from AANP. Results may not be changed or modified in any way. Upon completion, you will be issued a final invoice for the total cost, which must be paid in-full prior to receiving your final report. The total cost will be based on the amount of time spent on the request, so it could be higher or lower than the estimate.

Analytic Fees

AANP Members	\$100 / hour
Non-member	\$140 / hour

Fees are waived for members seeking salary information for their contract negotiations and the work takes less than 30 minutes to complete.
