### Nurse Practice Act

[59 Okl.St. Ann. § 567.1](#)

#### Regulatory Structure: Restricted Practice

State law restricts patient access to nurse practitioner (NP) care. State licensure law requires physician supervision for at least one element of NP practice.

#### Regulatory Agency

NP practice is regulated by the [Board of Nursing \(BON\)](#).

#### Licensure Requirements

Requirements include an RN license, a graduate degree in an NP role and national certification.

#### Schedule II Controlled Substance Prescriptive Authority

NPs are currently not authorized to hold Schedule II controlled substance prescriptive authority.

#### Continuing Education (CE)\*

CE is established by the BON. See the BON for details.

#### Medical Staff Membership†

Medical staff composition is determined in accordance with a facility's bylaws.

#### Supervisory Agreement Ratio‡

One physician may enter into supervisory agreements with no more than four full-time equivalent NPs or other Advanced Practice Registered Nurses (APRNs) regarding their prescriptive authority, up to a maximum of four total NPs or APRNs.

#### Signature Recognition on Items of Patient Care

- **Physical Therapy:** NPs are authorized to refer to physical therapy.
- **Parking Permits:** NPs are authorized to provide proof of disability for disabled parking permits.
- **DNR:** NPs are not presently authorized to sign Do Not Resuscitate orders.
- **Death Certificates:** NPs are not currently authorized to sign death certificates.
- **Provider Orders for Life Sustaining Treatment (POLST):** NPs are not authorized to sign POLST forms.
